



Dmitri A. Bulushev graduated from the Novosibirsk State University (Russia) and joined the Boreskov Institute of Catalysis SB RAS (Novosibirsk), where he received his PhD degree in Chemistry (Chemical Kinetics and Catalysis) in 1991. From 1995 to 2007 he was a researcher at the University of Ghent (Belgium) and EPFL (Switzerland) and then a senior researcher at the University of Limerick (Ireland). Since 2014 Dmitri is working as a senior researcher at the Boreskov Institute of Catalysis SB RAS and Nikolaev Institute of Inorganic Chemistry SB RAS. His research area includes studies of mechanisms of catalytic reactions, elucidation of factors determining the activity and selectivity of catalysts and application of novel carbon materials as catalyst's supports. Dmitri is a co-author of about 60 papers with peer review.
