



Dmitry I. Levshov is a researcher at the laboratory of “Structure and Dynamics of Individual Nanosystems” at the Physics Department of the Southern Federal University (Rostov-on-Don, Russia). He received his PhD in Physics from University Montpellier 2 (France) and from Southern Federal University in 2013 and 2014, respectively, in the framework of the co-tutelle de thèse. His research interests include growth, study, and characterization of individual free-standing carbon nanotubes. In particular, he focuses on the study of the intrinsic optical and phonon properties of individual few-layered carbon nanotubes by combination of Electron Diffraction, High-Resolution Electron Microscopy, Raman spectroscopy and Rayleigh Spectroscopy.
